

Capturing Video from VCR to PC using Windows Movie Maker

1. Double-click the “Windows Movie Maker” icon on the desktop.
2. In the left-hand pane, make sure that “1. Capture Video” is expanded to show all the options.
3. Click “Capture from video device.”
4. Make sure that Video Capture Device is set to “AVC Compliant DV Device” and click Next.
5. In the Captured Video dialog box, enter a name for the video clip and choose a directory to save it in. I suggest you use the “My Videos” folder of your own documents folder. This should be the default.
6. Click Next.
7. In the Video Setting dialog box, make sure that “Best Quality for playback on My Computer” is selected.
8. Click Next.
9. You will see a preview of what is playing on the VCR on the right.
10. Click “Start Capture” to begin capturing video.
11. Click “Stop Capture” to stop the capture.
12. Click “Finish.”
13. You can then play your finished clip in the window. This clip can also be placed directly into Powerpoint presentations.
